

DECODE - PRIVACY POLICY

Version 2.0 - Effective date: May 31, 2026

IMPORTANT: This Privacy Policy explains how Decode handles your information. By using Decode, you agree to this Policy. If you do not agree, do not use the Services.

1. INTRODUCTION

Decode is a decentralized non-custodial meta-aggregator. We do not control your wallet, private keys, or blockchain transactions. This Policy describes our data practices.

This Policy is part of the Terms of Use. Capitalized terms not defined here have the meaning given in the Terms.

2. NO PERSONAL DATA COLLECTION

Decode does NOT collect any personal information about you, such as:

- your name, email, postal address, or phone number.
- government IDs (passport, driver's license, etc.).
- payment card or bank account details.
- biometric or health data.

We do not require you to create an account or log in. You interact with Decode only through your blockchain wallet.

We maintain no database of users, wallets, or transaction history. Any data temporarily processed for a quote or route is not stored beyond the immediate request.

3. BLOCKCHAIN DATA - PUBLIC AND IMMUTABLE

When you use Decode, your wallet address and transaction details (tokens, amounts, recipient, smart contract interaction) are broadcast to the blockchain. This data is:

- Public - anyone can view it using a blockchain explorer.
- Immutable - it cannot be altered or deleted.
- Pseudonymous - your real identity is not directly attached, but analytics may link addresses over time.

Decode cannot hide, delete, or modify blockchain data. You assume all risks of public transactions.

Your wallet address may be visible to other users (e.g., in custom recipient fields). For privacy, use separate wallets for different activities.

Decode does not actively collect wallet addresses. However, when you request a quote or initiate a transaction, your wallet address may be sent to third-party services (see section 6) temporarily. Decode does not retain this data, but third parties may have their own practices.

4. TECHNICAL DATA AND IP ADDRESSES

Like most web servers, our infrastructure may automatically log technical information when you visit the Decode website, including:

- your IP address.
- browser type and version.
- operating system.
- referring website.
- date, time, and duration of visit.
- pages or features accessed.

We use this data for legitimate purposes:

- diagnosing server problems and debugging.
- preventing denial-of-service attacks.
- analyzing usage patterns to improve the Services.
- complying with legal obligations (e.g., lawful requests).

We do not intentionally link IP addresses to wallet addresses. However, in exceptional circumstances (court order, security incident), we may correlate logs as required by law.

IP logs are retained for up to 30 days, unless a longer retention is needed for security or legal reasons. After that, logs are deleted or anonymized.

5. COOKIES AND LOCAL STORAGE

No tracking cookies - Decode does not use cookies for advertising, analytics, or tracking.

Local storage (browser localStorage/sessionStorage) may be used to remember your preferences locally, such as:

- network filters.
- slippage tolerance.
- state of "Your Tokens" section.

This data never leaves your device, is not sent to our servers, and is not a cookie. You can clear local storage in your browser settings at any time.

Third-party cookies - Decode does not embed third-party scripts. However, if you follow a link from Decode to an external website, that site may set its own cookies. Decode is not responsible for those.

6. THIRD-PARTY SERVICES AND THEIR DATA PRACTICES

Decode integrates many third-party services (liquidity protocols, bridges, data feeds, RPC nodes, wallet connectors) to provide quotes, routing, and transaction execution.

When you use Decode, the following data may be transmitted to third parties:

- your wallet address (to check balances, simulate transactions, or route a bridge).
- token addresses and amounts you wish to swap or bridge.
- slippage tolerance.
- your IP address (if the third party is called directly from your browser - some requests go through our backend instead).

Decode does not control how third-party services collect, use, or store your data. Each third party has its own privacy policy. You are encouraged to review them. Decode is not responsible for third-party data practices.

Examples:

- When you request a swap quote, Decode may send your tokens and amount to several aggregator APIs. Those APIs may log your IP address and request parameters.
- When you initiate a bridge, the bridge's relayers may record your wallet address and bridged amount.
- When you connect your wallet via a connector service, that service may temporarily see your session data.

Any data Decode receives from third parties (e.g., a quote result) is used only to display information to you and is not stored or repurposed.

7. DATA SECURITY

We implement reasonable technical and organizational measures to protect the data we control (mainly server logs), including:

- encryption in transit (TLS/SSL).
- access controls limiting internal access to logs.
- regular security updates and monitoring.

However, no method of transmission over the internet is 100% secure. We cannot guarantee absolute security.

Blockchain data is outside our control. You assume all risks of public and immutable blockchain records.

8. DATA RETENTION

Technical logs (IP addresses, browser info) are retained for up to 30 days, unless a longer period is required for security investigations or legal compliance. After that, logs are deleted or anonymized.

Decode does not store any transaction history. If you need a record of your swaps or bridges, use a blockchain explorer or keep your own records.

In exceptional circumstances (court order, legal obligation), we may retain data longer than the standard period.

9. CHILDREN'S PRIVACY

Decode is not intended for persons under 18. We do not knowingly collect any information from children. By using Decode, you represent that you are at least 18 years old.

If you believe a child has used Decode, contact us. We will take reasonable steps to delete any inadvertently collected data (though blockchain data cannot be deleted).

10. INTERNATIONAL DATA TRANSFERS

Blockchains are global by design. Your wallet address and transaction details are broadcast to nodes and validators worldwide, which may involve transfers to countries with different data protection laws.

Decode's servers may be located in various jurisdictions (e.g., British Virgin Islands, or where our hosting providers operate). By using Decode, you consent to such transfers.

11. YOUR RIGHTS AND CHOICES

Because Decode collects no personal information (name, email, etc.), many traditional privacy rights (access, rectification, deletion, portability) may not apply. However, for technical logs that could be associated with you (e.g., IP address logs), you have the right to request access or deletion.

To exercise these rights, contact support@Decode.bet with sufficient information to identify the data (e.g., IP address and date range). We will respond as required by law.

We may not be able to delete data subject to legal retention obligations (e.g., pending litigation). We will inform you if that is the case.

Blockchain data cannot be deleted - it is permanent and outside our control.

Decode does not respond to "Do Not Track" signals because we do not engage in cross-site tracking.

12. CHANGES TO THIS PRIVACY POLICY

We may update this Policy at any time. Changes are effective immediately after posting on the Decode website, with a new "Effective date".

If we make material changes, we will provide reasonable notice (e.g., a notice on the website). Your continued use after changes constitutes acceptance.

You are responsible for reviewing this Policy periodically.
